

After Care Information

Recognizing the need to help working parents, Saint Ann School will continue with its After Care Program for the 2017-2018 School Year. This program is open to children from Pre-School through Grade 8 and will run daily until 6 PM.

Emergency Care will be available if a parent is running late and can't get to school for dismissal time. You will be able to contact the school on short notice and ask that your child stay with the After Care Staff. Please make sure you speak with someone if this happens.

There will be a certified teacher in charge of each session. Snacks should be brought from home. On Early Dismissal Days, lunch must be brought to school. Following is a sample of how a typical session will run:

2:30 - 3:00 settling in, snack time
3:00 - 4:00 homework help
4:00 - 6:00 age appropriate activities, arts and crafts, movies.
Activities will be expanded during longer sessions.

In order to be able to take part in After Care, parents must register. There is a yearly registration fee of \$25.00 per family. You must register your child in order to participate in any of the sessions.

Fee Schedule:

Registration : \$25 per family (even if you are only using After Care as Emergency Care.)

Session 1:	2:30-4:00 PM	\$10
Session 2:	2:30-6:00 PM	\$20
Session 3:	12:00 – 4:00 PM	\$25 (Early Dismissal Days)
Session 4:	12:00 - 6:00 PM	\$35 (Early Dismissal Days)

Children must be picked up by 6 PM or a \$25 late charge will be assessed.

****Please note: All After Care bills must be satisfied by the end of the month that you are in currently. For example, September After Care must be paid by Sept. 30, etc. You will no longer be able to carry a balance. If a balance is left at the end of the month, then your child will not be able to participate in After Care until that balance is satisfied.**
